

## Compliance Reporting

If you would like Quinault Wellness Center to provide compliance reports to any entities such as the courts, Indian Child Welfare, Department of Corrections, Department of Licensing and/or the Department of Social and Health Services, we must have a current copy of the court order before we will submit any compliance reports per Washington Administrative Code 246-341-0640.

All compliance reports are based on your treatment contract you agreed to upon commencing services.

Please note and be aware of the following reporting mandates per the Washington Administrative Code (WAC):

WAC 246-341-0420 (13): Quinault Wellness Center will submit monthly reports within the first 10 days of the month unless there are incidences that fall within the 10 days. These incidences include:

WAC 246-341-0800 (1): reporting non-compliance within three working days when it's determined:

- Failure to maintain abstinence from alcohol and other non-prescribed drugs
- An patient's report of subsequent alcohol or drug related arrests or
- A patient leaving the program against program advice or discharged for rule violation

Reporting noncompliance within 10 days when:

- A patient's excused absences or failure to report, including failure to attend mandatory self-help groups or
- A patient's failure to make acceptable progress on any part of the care plan.
